

How Can We Worship The Creator God In Spirit And In Truth ?

John 4:23-24 [Amplified Bible] *“A time will come, however, indeed it is already here, when the true, genuine worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth, reality. For the Father is seeking just such people as these as His worshippers. God is Spirit, a spiritual Being, and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth, reality.”*

What is the key to such worship?

Romans 12:1 [Amplified Bible] *“I appeal to you therefore, brethren, and beg you in view of all the mercies of God, to make a decisive dedication of your bodies, presenting all your members and faculties, as a living sacrifice. Holy, devoted, consecrated and well pleasing to God, which is your reasonable, rational and intellectual service and **spiritual worship.**”*

The Greek word translated “*bodies*” encompasses every part of our experience of life. It includes our physical bodies, our mind and the spirit within us.

Job 32:8 [Amplified Bible] *“... There is a vital force, a spirit of intelligence, in man, the breath of the almighty that gives men understanding.”*

It is the spirit within us that gives us the experience of existence. This spirit is also the link we have with the spirit world in which our Creator God exists.

This invisible but very real part of our life is the spirit referred to in **John 4:23-24** as quoted above.

What about the truth being part of this worship God desires?

John 17:17 [Amplified Bible] *“Sanctify them, purify, consecrate, separate them for Yourself, make them Holy by the Truth, Your Word is Truth.”*

The “*Word*” referred to in this scripture is dual. It is (a) the physically recorded words that God uttered and inspired, the ‘**Handbook for Life**’, the Holy Bible;

(b) the personification of these words in the Person of Jesus Christ.

When our spirit, the Holy Spirit and the Word of God come together then true worship is experienced.

This true worship is the intimate communication we can have with our Creator God existing in the spiritual realm.

The Holy Spirit, the Person of the Godhead who works with and in us at this time does **not** speak to us in audible words for these are part of the physical world, the movement of air particles.

The Holy Spirit communicates with spiritual thoughts directly into the spirit in us. Thoughts which do not occupy space or time are the means of communication in the spirit realm.

Psalm 46:10 [Amplified Bible] *“Let be and be still, and know, recognise and understand, that I am God...”*

God is telling us that it is **only** during periods of silence away from the noise of this society that allows the Holy Spirit to communicate with us, in this way.

By personal experience this happens when the Holy Spirit interrupts my stream of words praising and thanking God in my private prayer. I now have a notepad and pen beside me on my knees to record such thoughts that interrupt my prayers.

This is the intimate, personal and private relationship that our Creator God desires to have with Him.

This is the means that God uses to bring us to maturity, feeding us with Christ, the Word.

John 6:55-56 [Amplified Bible] *“For My flesh is true and genuine food, and My blood is true and genuine drink. He who feeds on My flesh and drinks My blood dwells continually in Me, and I in like manner dwell continually in him.”*

This is the *“Holy Communion”* that our Creator God desires to have with us on a daily basis.
